RISE has been working with Mousumi Ghosh since 2013. She loves to attend Yearn to Learn classes, however, as one of our oldest students, Mousumi requires a great deal of help in order to be fully literate in Bengali.

Mousumi lives with her mother, father, brother and Grandmother in a small room which contains all their possessions; they do not have their own home and distant relatives have given them this space. RISE is working to help Mousumi's family receive Government Benefits to build their own concrete structure and toilet as well as avail of rations and subsidies to support the family.
